

| | In the 12 months ending December 31st, 2010 there were 644 sales of all property types in Campbell River, a decline of 13% over the same period in 2009. The highest number of annual sales was 1181 in 2007. |
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| | The 12 month average sale price of a Campbell River home is \$294,372, up 5%. The average lot price is \$99,856 down 11%. If you purchased an <i>'average'</i> home in 2006, you paid \$265,602. If you bought an average lot, you paid \$103,171. |
| | 36 houses a month sold in 2010. (For 2009 the number was 44, for 2008 - 38, for 2007 -58, for 2006 - 54.) 83% of all residential sales occurred in Campbell River City – 41% and Willow Point – 42%. Houses make up 71% of the 376 <i>residential</i> properties currently offered for sale while strata titles are 24%. Compare this ratio to the Comox Valley where houses make up 55% of the inventory, strata 38%. The active inventory of all properties is 665, up 27% since December 31st, 2009 . |
| | The greatest current price differential is between Willow Point (\$308,112) and Quinsam/Campbellton (\$220,841.) |
| | In 2009, 67 houses sold for under $$200,000$. In 2010 - 36. There were 26 sales over $$500,000$ in 2008. In 2009 -10. In 2010 – 15. The 12 month median price (half sales above, half below is $$298,000$.) |
